## WELCOME!

Conversations on Performance is a 7-day seminar from June 2 to 8, 2022 as part of the 16th edition of Festival TransAmériques. FTA will take place in Montreal from May 25 to June 9, 2022.

Open to a maximum of fifteen young Canadian professional artists aged 25 to 35, this project takes the form of a seminar held in English and based on six shows presented during FTA. Participants are encouraged to expand their ideas about contemporary theatre and dance, confront their artistic realities and critical thinking, and to share their expertise with their peers. A cultural project coordinator will serve as a consultant during the project.

For its second edition, Conversations on Performance will include English-language artists from Montreal, across Quebec and from other provinces in Canada. We hope to eventually open it up to participants from other countries in the years to come.

## PRACTICAL INFO

### Danse + Théâtre

- The average temperature for the months of May and June is 17 degrees Celsius during the day and 12 degrees Celsius in the evening. Sun, rain, cloud, 15 degrees, 30 degrees. Get ready for everything. The weather is changeable, and the temperature drops at night.
- TAXES AND TIPS - Prices indicated on most goods and services in Quebec do not include taxes (around 15%), added at checkout. Service is never included in restaurants or bars, so it is customary to add a 15% to 18% tip to the total amount before tax.
  - **Tiping at the FTA's HQ:** the tip **isn't included** with the coupons!
- **Airport Shuttle - Downtown - 747 Express Bus**  
Connects Downtown and the Quartier des spectacles to the Pierre-Elliott-Trudeau Airport. Runs 24/7. Bus every 30 minutes during the day.  
**\$10 cash (coins only) when embarking on the bus.** Tickets available at the counter located inside each metro station, also in machines at Montréal airport YUL.  
Bus Ride: 45 to 70 minutes depending on traffic.
- **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION (STM)**  
1 trip: 3, 50\$  
2 trips: 6,50\$  
10 trips: 30\$ (only available with Opus card)  
Unlimited evening (6 pm to 5 am), 5,75 \$  
Occasional card: 10 \$/day or 20,50 \$/3 days  
1-day ticket - Airport Shuttle: 10 \$
- **BIXI - SELF-SERVE BICYCLES | 514 789 2494**  
1 \$ + 15¢/minute (Regular BIXI) or 30¢/minute (Electric BIXI)  
Credit card payment only.
- **TAXI**  
Cash, credit & debit card payment available. It is customary to add a \$1 to \$2 tip per ride.
